Let's play Slides and Ladders!

*Two to four players can
play this classic game
with a safety twist.*

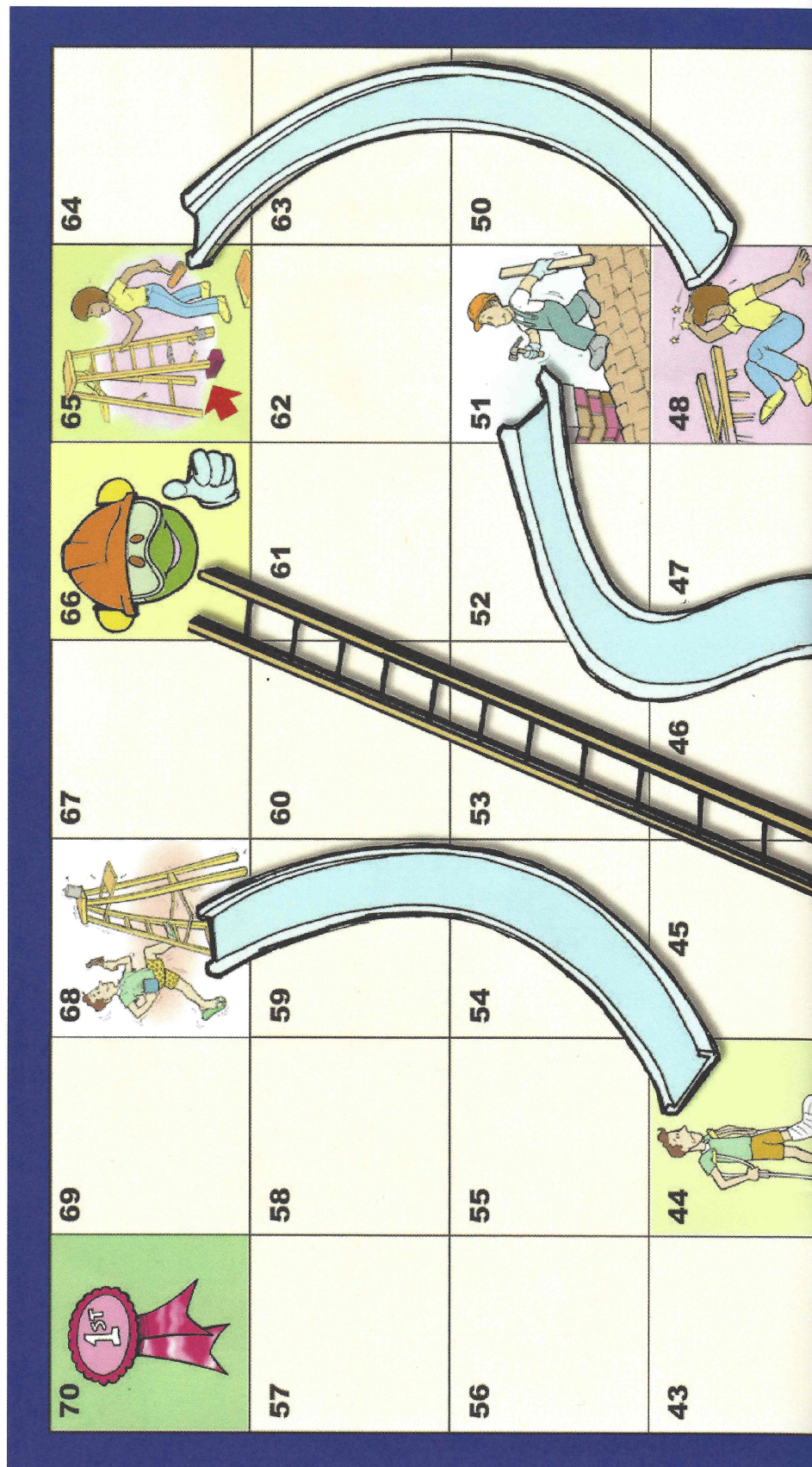


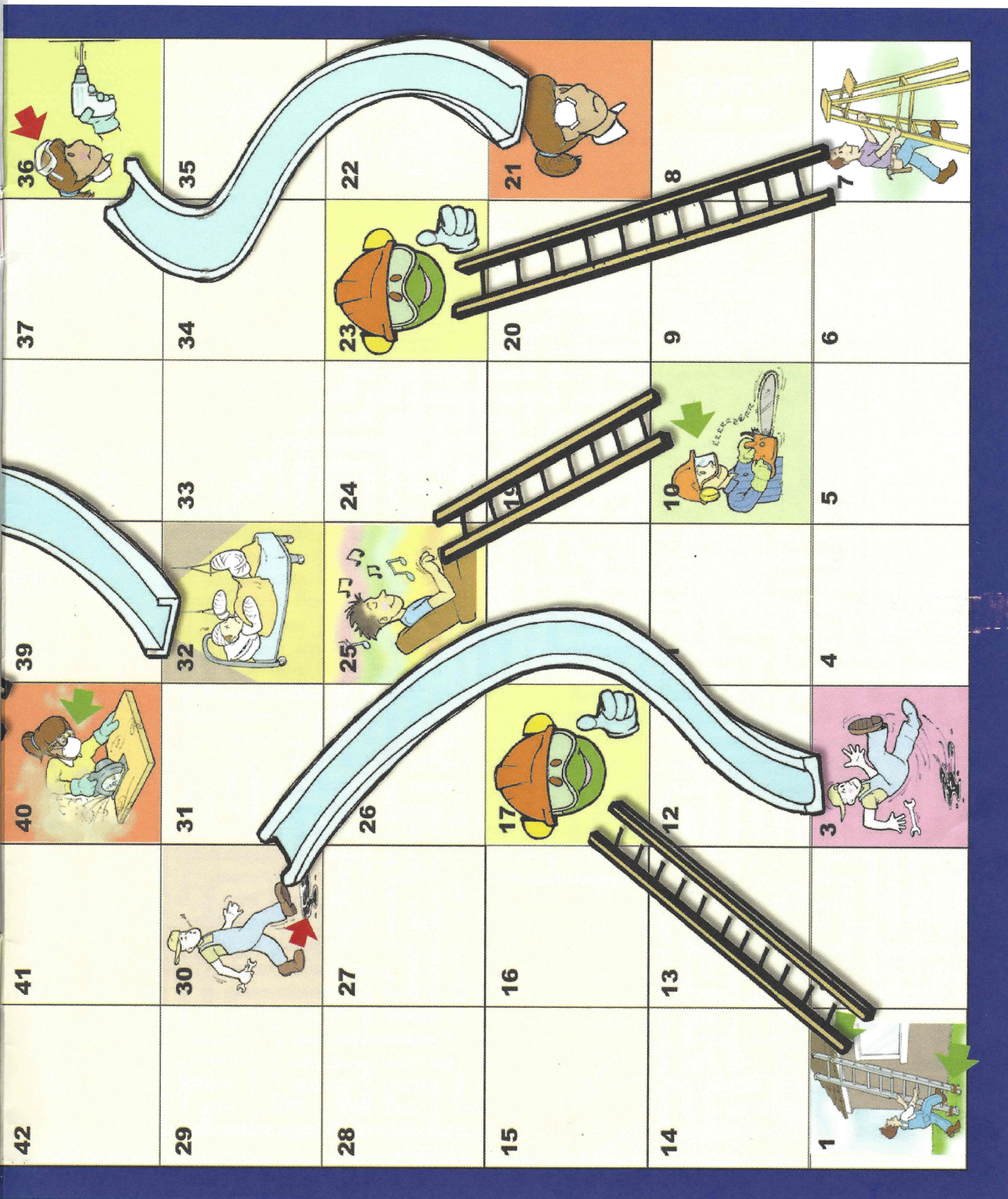
What you need:

- A counter or token for each player
- One dice

How to play:

1. Each player chooses a counter.
2. Put all counters on the first square (marked "1").
3. Roll the dice to see who will play first. The highest number wins.
4. The first player rolls the dice, then moves his/her counter the number of squares shown on the dice.
5. The other players take turns rolling the dice and moving their counters.
6. If players land at the bottom of a ladder, they move to the top of the ladder.
7. If players land at the top of a slide, they move to the bottom of the slide.
8. The first player to land on the last square (number 70) wins the game.

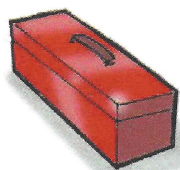
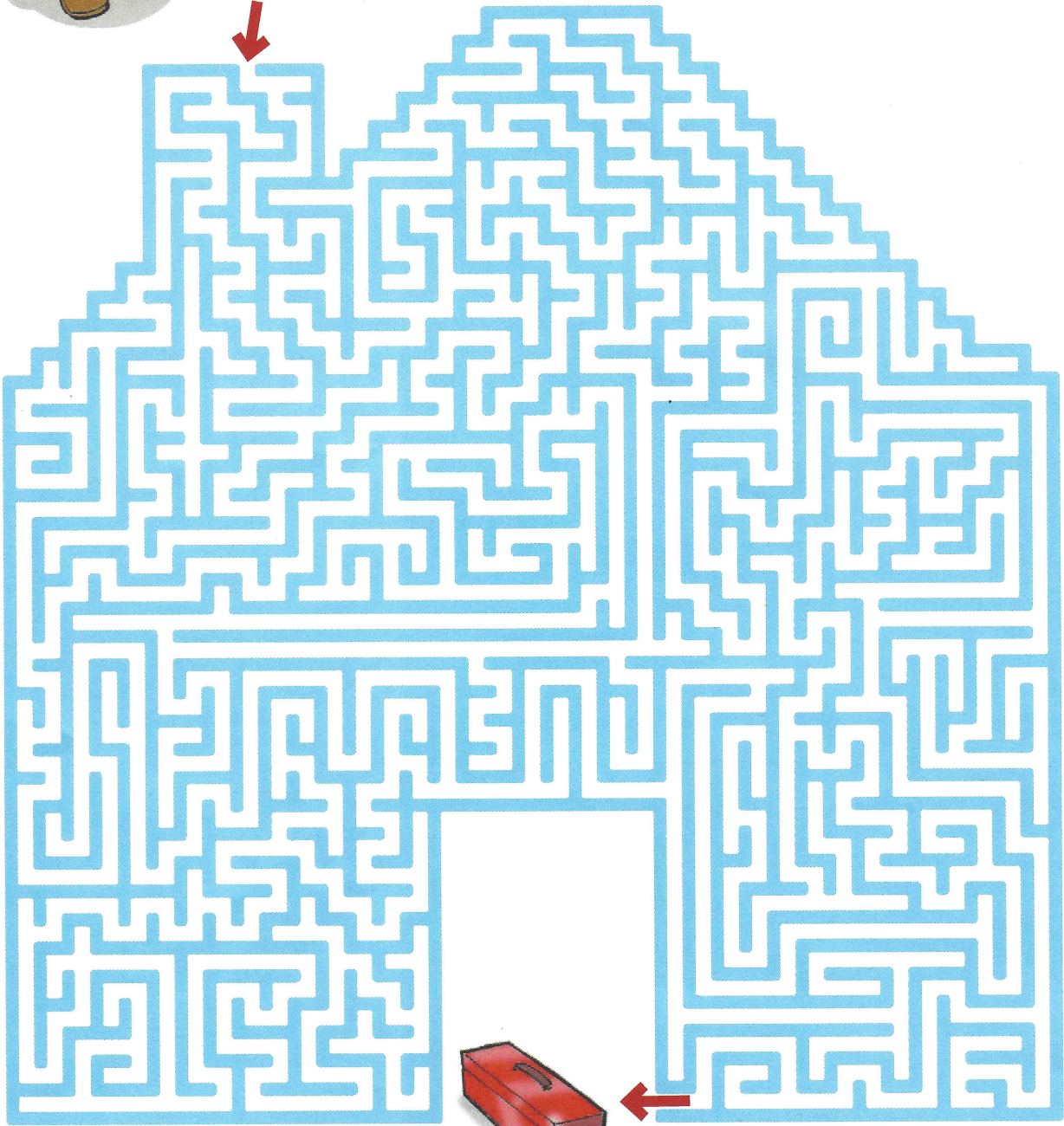

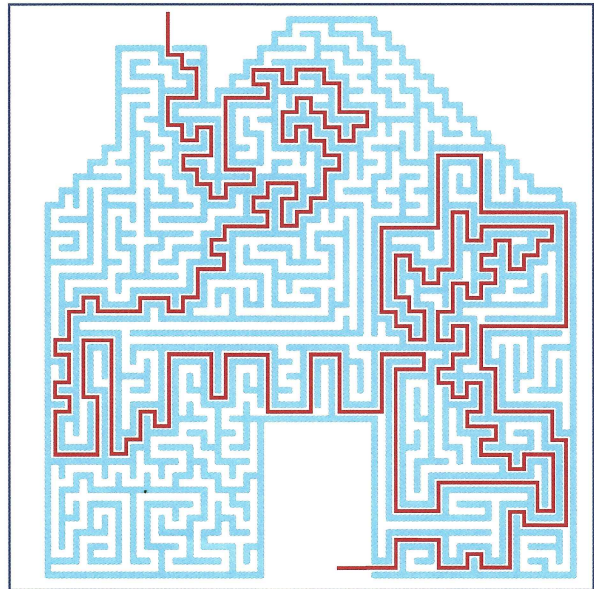

(1) The man wears flip-flops and (2) carries a bucket while climbing the ladder.



(7) The woman does not wear safety eyewear while using the circular saw.



(11) The man uses a belt sander without wearing a dust mask or safety eyewear.



(3) The ladder is not tied off, and (4) it is too close to overhead power lines (image to come).



(8) The piece of wood is not clamped down, so it could move.



(12) The mobile equipment operator backs up toward the young girl. The two people do not make eye contact.



(5) The boy on the roof is not wearing any fall protection equipment.



(9) The baby plays too close to the woman using the saw.



(13) The balcony has no guardrails.



(6) Also, he left a hammer on the roof, and has kicked it off. It falls toward a woman.



(10) The backhoe operator has struck a water main. He forgot to "dial before you dig."



(14) The stepladder is broken. (15) The woman leans away from the ladder.



(16) The handle of the paint roller is too short to reach the ceiling.
